The June 16, 2022 special meeting of the Fromberg Town Council was held at the Fromberg School Gym in Fromberg Montana. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tim Nottingham at 7:00 pm. Council members present were Nate Caton, Dave Stapleton and James Lister. Others officials present were, Jay Carter with the Public Works Department and the Fromberg town clerk, Lacey Breeding. Also present was Serena Allen with DES, Sheriff McQuillan, County Commissioner Scott Miller, Amy Highfield(DNRC)and Erin Cross (Public health),

Mayor Nottingham welcomed the attendees and introduced Amy Highfield with DNRC. Highfield introduced her team and explained what current operations were in action.

Next Sheriff Mcquillan gave updates on patrol efforts on the east side of Fromberg. McQuillan also cautioned to be aware of possible looting.

Commissioner Scott Miller gave updates on road closures and bridge issues.


Next Cyrina Allen explained how to sign up for the code-red alerts to receive important notifications in the future.

Mayor Nottingham gave information stressing on documentation throughout this flood disaster. Discussion was had about dumpsters for flood debris.


