

FROMBERG TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES OF A SPECIAL FLOOD MEETING

HELD ON JUNE 29, 2022

The June 29, 2022 special meeting of the Fromberg Town Council was held at the Fromberg School Gym in Fromberg Montana. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tim Nottingham at 7:00 pm. Council members present were Nate Caton, Dave Stapleton, Bill Gruel and James Lister. Others officials present were, Jay Carter with the Public Works Department, the Fromberg town clerk, Lacey Breeding, Jeff Bates with State DES and Cyrina Allen with County DES.

Mayor Nottingham welcomed the attendees. He then started the topics off by addressing the issue with scammers within the town. He warned to be aware and ask for proof of professional identity.

Nottingham then asked Councilman Lister to give up dates on the dumpsters and debris. Councilman Lister gave details of the amounts of debris coming, that it is slowing down and he suggested we start coming up with a termination date for the dumpsters. Discussion was then had about how much debris is left to discard and gather. The council decided to reassess the dumpster need in another 2 weeks.

Next, Jeff Bates and Cyrina Allen with DES, gave information on FEMA time lines and what to expect in the coming weeks pre-disaster.

Then Councilman Gruel asked for the council to access the utility charges that would be accrued by the residents on the east side of town during their cleanup efforts. Discussion was had on reasoning for those residents to accrue higher than normal water usage. Ultimately it was agreed to discuss the topic further during the next regular council meeting in July.


Discussion was then had about the mosquito problem the flood waters brought to town and the options available to try and reduce it.

Next Mayor Nottingham announced that the Fromberg School needed to be restored to their normal uses to get ready for the upcoming school year and get their planned projects completed. He informed that a date of July 8, 2022 had been decided as a deadline to close down the relief efforts that are being held

inside the Fromberg gym and make plans to relocate. Discussion was had on possible options for new locations.


