

FROMBERG TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 01, 2022


The September 01, 2022 special meeting of the Fromberg Town Council was held at the Fromberg Town Hall in Fromberg Montana. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited at 7:15 pm and Mayor Nottingham called the meeting to order. Council members present were Nate Caton, Dave Stapleton, Bill Gruel and James Lister. Others present were, Jay Carter with the Public Works Department and the Fromberg town clerk, Lacey Breeding. Also present were Elton Kirtley, Jerry Hall, Tina Foust, Phil Dehaan and Irwin Sankey. Missing was Councilman Bill Gruel.

Mayor Nottingham welcomed the attendees and explained the reasons for this special meeting. He then proceeded to give the details about a failing sewer main in town. PWD, Jay Carter, explained what has been done so far and what needs to be done to fix it as soon as possible. He then provided an estimate he had gathered on fixing the situation. Discussion was had about the amount on the quote and possible grants to apply for. Ultimately the council agreed to accept the presented bid. Councilman Stapleton made the motion seconded by Councilman Caton. The motion was carried as follows: Councilman Caton, -aye, Councilman Stapleton, -aye, Councilman Lister, -aye.

The remaining topic on the agenda was a decision to be made on whether or not to extend a water main further on Carbon Steet. Carter explained the location and what the extension would be for. He then provided a quote from Core and Main for the supplies to accomplish the project. Discussion was had on the pros and cons of the possible extension. A motion to extend the water line and accept the bid for parts and supplies was made by Councilman Stapleton. Councilman Caton gave a second and the motion was carried out as follows: Councilman Caton, -aye, Councilman Stapleton, -aye and Councilman Lister, -aye.


